HANDICAP REQUIREMENTS

Type 1 – New Applicants who do not have an existing PC are required to obtain a Proficiency Certificate (PC), attend a Golf Workshop & submit scorecards from recently played golf games (5 X 18 Holes or 10 X 9 Holes) prior to attending the Handicap Test (Courtesy Round).

Type 2 – Transfer in Applicants are required to give a copy of their Handicapping History & Scoring Data from their previous Home Club; failing which they will be processed as a Type 3 Application.

Type 3 – Transfer in Applicants are required to give a copy of their existing Handicap cards (Non USGA) and or a letter of verification from their previous Home Club; failing which they will be processed as a Type 1 Application.

Type 3 – Transfer in Applicants may submit scorecards from recently played golf games (5 X 18 Holes or 10 X 9 Holes); failing which, they will be issued with a Committee Assigned Handicap Index until the required scorecards are submitted.

HANDICAP TEST / COURTESY ROUND

Prior to the awarding of a USGA Handicap Index, a member of Golf Alliance's Handicap Committee will conduct a Courtesy Round (CR) to ensure that members: Possess a reasonable understanding of the rules of golf / Are aware of the etiquettes required before, during and after a round of golf / Possess the required golf skills and playing ability.

PRE-REQUISITES FOR THE COURTESY ROUND To be eligible for the CR, candidates must have:

- Obtained a Proficiency Certificate / Attended and passed the workshop on golf rules and etiquette
- Submitted 10 x 9 –hole scorecards or 5 x 18 –hole scorecards from recently played golf games.

(Note: The cards submitted must be from courses that meet with USGA Handicap System requirements: i.e. the course must have a USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating, and must be at least 1,350m for 9 holes, or at least 2,700m for 18 holes. Scores from courses that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted.)

CONDUCT OF THE COURTESY ROUND The CR will be conducted over a 9 holes golf game

- **Turnout:** Candidates must show up 15 minutes before the appointed tee-off time. Applicants who are late will be considered to have committed a major fault.
- **Dress Code:** Proper golfing attire; T-shirt with collar, tailored pants, shorts (or skirts for ladies) and golf shoes.
- **Rules and etiquette:** Failure to show basic etiquette is considered a major fault. Similarly, failure to demonstrate understanding of a golf rule will also be considered a major fault.
- **Golf skills:** Candidates must demonstrate a reasonable ball striking ability & complete 9 holes with a reasonable score.
- A candidate with two or more major faults will be deemed to have not met with the qualifying standards of the CR.

2. You may combine Multiple Insurance Policies for the purpose of joint claims from excess bills. E.g. If a Medical claim exceeds the limit, you may claim the balance using the other policies which you may have.
